- Bulky waste (couches, mattresses, large furniture items and residential construction materials)
- Automobile tires
- Used motor oil and anti-freeze
- Yard waste (brush cut and tied, less than four inches in diameter, no longer than six feet in length)
- Metal appliances (washers, refrigerators, etc.)
