

## BOARD OF ETHICS

"Ch. 1., Div. 2, Article 9, Sec. 161. Administration, procedure and enforcement. (a) A Board of Ethics is hereby created which shall consist of five (5) members serving without compensation, to be appointed by the Mayor. The members shall be resident electors of the City of Waterbury and no more than three (3) shall be registered members of the same political party. They shall not be employees or officers of the City of Waterbury and shall not be members or officers of any Board, Commission or agency of the City of Waterbury. They shall serve for overlapping five-year terms. Initially the first of such original appointments shall expire on July 31, 1974 the second shall expire July 31, 1975, the third shall expire July 31, 1976, the fourth shall expire July 31, 1977 and the fifth shall expire July 31, 1978. All successive appointments to be for full five-year terms. (b) The Board of Ethics shall elect a chairman from within its membership by a majority vote to serve for a term of two (2) years."
