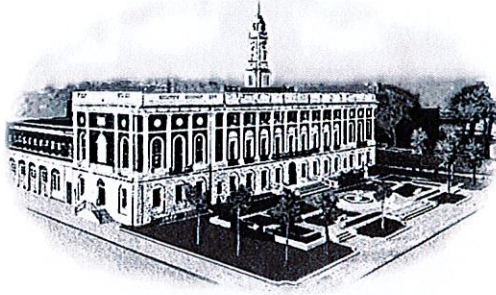

EMERGENCY DECLARATION

Whereas, across the State of Connecticut and the City of Waterbury, there continues to be an extreme fire condition with a Red Flag Warning issued by the National Weather Service. Emergency actions are required to protect the life and property of the City's residents.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Paul K. Pernerewski, Jr., the Mayor of the City of Waterbury, acting by authority vested in me by the Charter of the City of Waterbury, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT in conjunction with the Declaration of Civil Preparedness issued by Governor Ned Lamont for the Red Flag Warning, **there shall be no open burning permitted** in the City of Waterbury for any purpose. Any open burning will be immediately extinguished by the Waterbury Fire Department. These measures will remain in effect until weather conditions improve and a significant fire threat is no longer present.

This order shall take effect immediately and will remain in effect until lifted by me in writing.
