#### Renters' Rebate

65+ or totally disabled with income \$40,300 or less (single), \$49,100 or less (married). Filing period April 1 - Oct. 1, 2023. <u>Documents Required</u>: Proof of last year's income: Previous year's tax return and Social Security 1099, or if did not file, all 1099 forms including SS 1099 and proof of rent and utilities paid in previous year via note from Landlord or payment records. #### **MyHomeCT**

The MyHomeCT Program will offer grant assistance (up to \$50,000) which can reinstate ("catch-up"), provide up to 12 months' worth of go-forward payments, or a combination of both to eligible Connecticut homeowners who have suffered a financial hardship as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Qualified expenses for either program can include: real estate taxes (2018 Grand List forward), homeowners' insurance and flood insurance, water and sewer liens, ground lease or lot payments, condominium and/or homeowners' association fees, condominium and/or homeowners' association special assessments, fees that were advanced by the loan servicer/mortgage company on behalf of an applicant with a reverse mortgage. #### **Operation Fuel**

Applications are now open through November 10th, 2023. Operation Fuel provides emergency energy and utility assistance to households in Connecticut that are facing financial crisis. This program can help households that have received a shut off notice or is more than 30 days past due on electric, gas or water. Before you apply for Operation Fuel assistance, you need to gather proof of the last four weeks of income for all household members, the name of your fuel vendor (if you are a deliverable fuel customer), or your utility bill and payment history (if you are an electric, gas, and water customer). #### **CHOICES**

What is CHOICES? CHOICES is Connecticut's State Health Insurance assistance Program. Free and unbiased services are provided to Medicare-eligible individuals, families, and caregivers of all ages and income levels. One-on-one benefits counseling on all parts of Medicare, including Original Medicare (Parts A and B) Medicare Advantage (Part C), Medicare Supplement, and Prescription Drug Coverage (Part D), Enrollment assistance and plan comparisons for Medicare Advantage and standalone Part D plans, Eligibility Screening and application assistance with cost-assistance programs including Medicaid, the Medicare Savings Program, the Low-Income Subsidy/Extra Help Program. #### CT Energy Assistance Program (CEAP)

The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program helps Connecticut residents afford to heat their homes. Proof of income for all household members, copies of utility bills, Renters must show copies of their rent receipts or lease, names, date of births and social security numbers for all household members. #### Be Well Bus

If you need a ride to and from Waterbury Hospital, the Be Well Bus is a free service to patients. For a ride call: **203-573-7711**. The Be Well Bus runs on Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

#### Dial-A-Ride

Waterbury seniors call **203-756-5550** ext. **2** during the service hours of 9:00 to 4:00 pm on Mondays or Wednesdays. No cost for ride.

#### **ADA & Non-ADA Paratransit**

Dispatch is available at **203-756-5550 ext. 1** from 8:30am–4:30pm Hours: Mondays–Saturdays 5:30am–12:15am, Sundays 9:00a–5:15p

Must make reservations at least 24 hours in advance and up to 2 weeks in advance. Please let dispatcher know if you need assistance, or if you will be bringing a personal care assistant. \$3.50 each way, exact change required.

#### The Waterbury Senior Shuttle Program

First time riders must register by calling **203-346-3810 ext. 7274**. Then to schedule a ride call **(203) 757-5355**. Scheduling requires that you call 24 hours in advance between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Medical appointments can be made up to one (1) month in advance excluding weekends. Hours of Service are Monday through Friday: 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Saturday: 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.

#### Veyo

Non-Emergency Medical Transportation that is provided to eligible Medicaid members. Call **1-855-478-7350** Monday- Friday 7am-6pm and can be scheduled up to 30 days in advance.

#### **Managed Medicare Plan Transportation**

Some Medicare Advantage plans may offer non-emergency transportation benefits to plan members. Call the customer service number on the back of your card for more details of what your plan provides. Please note the church will be closed after November 21 and boxes will not be distributed after that date.

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
