Attorney General's Office Complaint System

ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Waterbury Senior Center is now accepting applications for the 2021/2022 program. The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program assists eligible households, with heating sources such as oil, natural gas, electricity, propane, kerosene, coal and wood/pellets. Homeowners and renters may apply. Eligibility for energy assistance is based on income, liquid assets and size of household. Please bring your latest statement for all bank accounts, CDs, credit union accounts, retirement accounts, stocks, shares and bonds. If you are employed we will require one month's worth of paystubs or if self-employed, we will require your tax return from the previous year. Those with pensions will need to submit a 1099 or letter from the pension company. We will also ask for your Eversource bill, date of births and social security numbers for all that reside in the home.

RENTER'S REBATE APPOINTMENTS

At The Waterbury Senior Center APRIL 1ST - OCTOBER 1ST

If you are a renter and turned 65 or were deemed Social Security Disabled in 2020 and your income is below \$37,600 for individuals and \$45,800 for couples, you may be eligible for a Rebate from the State of CT.

Please call the Senior Center at 203-574-6746 to make an appointment with Mira.

Please have with you:

- •A completed 2020 tax return including your SSA 1099 form (if you filed taxes), or your 2020 income (W2's, and all 1099 forms including the SSA 1099),
- •A letter from your landlord stating the total amount of rent that was paid in the year of 2020.
