## **Water/Sewer Delinquent Collection Program**

Delinquent Water/Sewer accounts are costly to all system users and unfair to those who pay their bills timely. The Bureau of Water has an aggressive collection program in place to reduce delinquent water and sewer rents, improve cash flow and stabilize the rates.

If you receive a delinquency notice it is your final opportunity to pay the bill, or make payment arrangements in order to avoid termination of your water service, additional costs and fees or even the collection of your tenants' rental payments. Water & Sewer Lien Assessment Procedure

Please be advised that, pursuant to the Charter of the City of Waterbury, section1B-5, liens will be assessed against all properties with unpaid prior calendar year water/sewer bills. A \$24.00 lien fee per service will become due and payable in addition to interest and principal.
