ROLL CALL administered to the Board of Aldermen-elect by City Clerk Michael J. Dalton. All members present.

OATH OF OFFICE administered to the entire Board of Aldermen-elect by City Clerk Michael J. Dalton.

1. TEMPORARY PRESIDENT:

Alderman Jeffrey Hunter placed **ALDERMAN KENNETH CURRAN** in nomination for Temporary President of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderman Michael Rinaldi.

Alderman Raphael Feliciano-Roman placed **ALDERWOMAN SANDRA MARTINEZ-McCARTHY** in nomination for Temporary President of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderman Michael Grosso.

There being no further nominations, nominations were **CLOSED** on motion by Alderman Sean Mosley, duly seconded by Alderwoman Belinda Weaver.

2. PERMANENT PRESIDENT:

Alderman Jeffrey Hunter placed **ALDERMAN MICHAEL DiGIOVANCARLO** in nomination for Permanent President of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderwoman Belinda Weaver.

Alderwoman Sandra Martinez-McCarthy placed **ALDERMAN RAFAEL FELICIANO-ROMAN** in nomination for Permanent President of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderman Michael Grosso.

There being no further nominations, nominations were **CLOSED** on motion by Alderman Sean Mosley, duly seconded by Aldermen John Drewry and Michael Rinaldi.

In favor of Alderman Michael DiGiovancarlo, to wit:~

On a roll call vote, Alderman Michael DiGiovancarlo received 10 votes and Alderman Rafael Feliciano-Roman received 5 votes. **ALDERMAN MICHAEL DiGIOVANCARLO** was declared elected **PERMANENT PRESIDENT** of the Board of Aldermen.

3. PRESIDENT PRO-TEMP:

Alderman John Drewry placed **ALDERMAN SEAN MOSLEY** in nomination for President Pro-Temp of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderman Michael Rinaldi.

Alderwoman Kelly Zimmermann placed **ALDERMAN ADRIAN SANCHEZ** in nomination for President Pro-Temp of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderman Rafael Feliciano-Roman.

There being no further nominations, nominations were **CLOSED** on motion by Alderman Jeffrey Hunter, duly seconded by Alderman Kenneth Curran.

On a roll call vote, Alderman Sean Mosley received 9 votes and Alderman Adrian Sanchez received 6 votes. **ALDERMAN SEAN MOSLEY** was declared elected **PRESIDENT PRO-TEMP** of the Board of Aldermen.

4. MAJORITY LEADER:

Alderman Ian Blake placed **ALDERWOMAN BELINDA WEAVER** in nomination for Majority Leader of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderman Sean Mosley.

Alderman Rafael Feliciano-Roman placed **ALDERWOMAN SANDRA MARTINEZ-McCARTHY** in nomination for Majority Leader of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Martinez-McCarthy.

There being no further nominations, nominations were **CLOSED** on motion by Alderman Rafael Feliciano-Roman, duly seconded by Alderman Jeffrey Hunter.

In favor of Alderman Sean Mosley, to wit:~

In favor of Alderwoman Sandra Martinez-McCarthy, to wit:~

On a roll call vote, Alderwoman Belinda Weaver received 8 votes and Alderwoman Sandra Martinez-McCarthy 2 votes. **ALDERWOMAN BELINDA WEAVER** was declared elected **MAJORITY LEADER** of the Board of Aldermen.

5. MINORITY LEADER:

Alderman Adrian Sanchez placed **ALDERWOMAN KELLY ZIMMERMANN** in nomination for Minority Leader of the Board of Aldermen. The nomination was duly seconded by Alderman Michael Grosso.

There being no further nominations, nominations were **CLOSED** on motion by Alderman George Noujaim, duly seconded by Alderman Michael Grosso.

On a unanimous {5-0} roll call vote, **ALDERWOMAN KELLY ZIMMERMANN** was elected to serve as **MINORITY LEADER** of the Board of Aldermen.

6. BYLAWS 2025-2027:

Alderwoman Belinda Weaver made a motion, duly seconded by Alderman Michael Rinaldi, to approve the Board of Aldermen bylaws for the term December 01, 2025 through November 30, 2027.

A motion made by Alderman Rafael Feliciano-Roman, and duly seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Martinez-McCarthy, to amend the current BOA bylaws, as submitted by President Michael DiGiovancarlo, by adopting new language/substitute language offered by Alderman Feliciano-Roman, **FAILED by a 9 nay - 6 yea roll call vote.**

Nays: Aldermen Blake, Curran, Drewry, Hunter, Mosley, Noujaim, Rinaldi, Weaver, and DiGiovancarlo ~ 9.

Yeas: Aldermen Feliciano-Roman, Grosso, Martinez-McCarthy, McEntee, Sanchez, and Zimmermann ~ 6.

As the amendment FAILED, the Board proceeded to vote on the original motion.

BOA President Michael DiGiovancarlo relinquished the chair to President Pro-Temp Alderman Sean Mosley.

A motion made by Alderman Rafael Feliciano-Roman, and duly seconded by Alderwoman Sandra Martinez-McCarthy, to amend Rule No. 1 on Page 3 of BOA bylaws submitted by BOA President Michael DiGiovancarlo, **FAILED by an 8 nay - 7 yea roll call vote.**

Nays: Aldermen Blake, Curran, Drewry, Hunter, Mosley, Rinaldi, Weaver, and DiGiovancarlo ~ 8.

Yeas: Aldermen Feliciano-Roman, Grosso, Martinez-McCarthy, Noujaim, McEntee, Sanchez, and Zimmermann ~ 7.

As the amendment FAILED, the Board proceeded to vote on the original motion.

On a motion of Alderwoman Belinda Weaver, duly seconded by Alderman Michael Rinaldi, the BOA Bylaws the submitted by President Michael DiGiovancarlo for the term December 01, 2025 through November 30, 2027, were **ADOPTED by a 9 yea - 6 nay roll call vote.**

Yeas: Aldermen Blake, Curran, Drewry, Hunter, Mosley, Noujaim, Rinaldi, Weaver, and DiGiovancarlo ~ 9.

Nays: Aldermen Feliciano-Roman, Grosso, Martinez-McCarthy, McEntee, Sanchez, and Zimmermann ~ 6.
