**January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021**

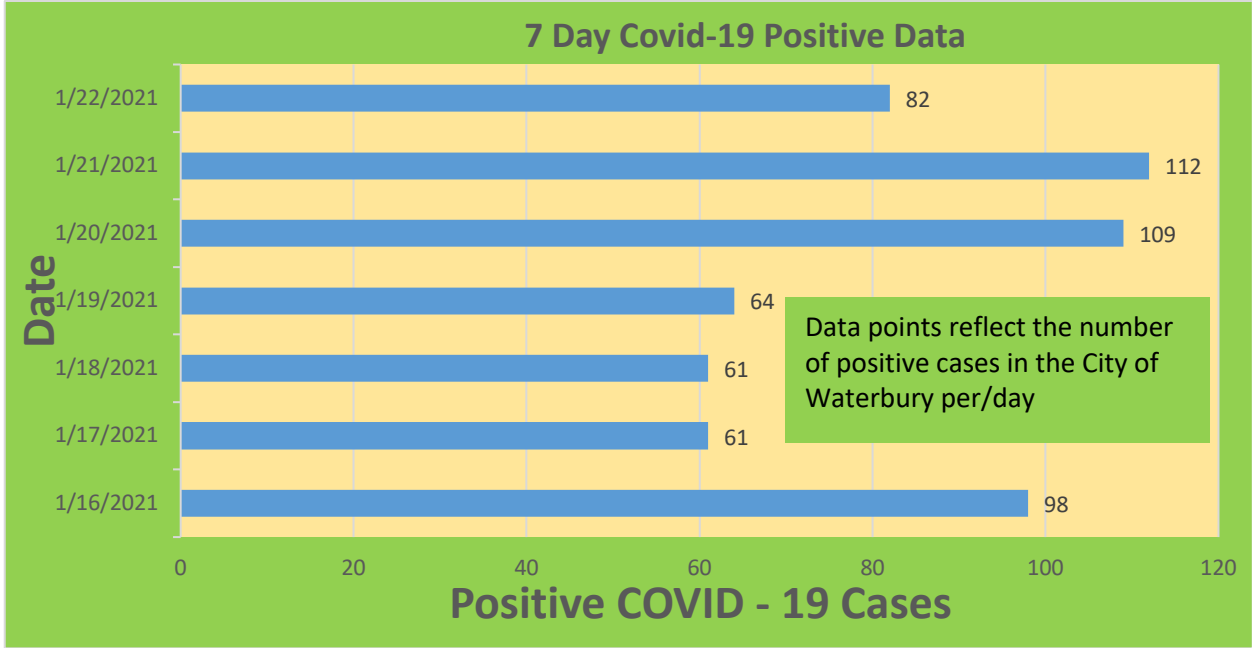
As of January 23<sup>rd</sup> 2021, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 10,526. Sixty patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 292 COVID-19-associated deaths.

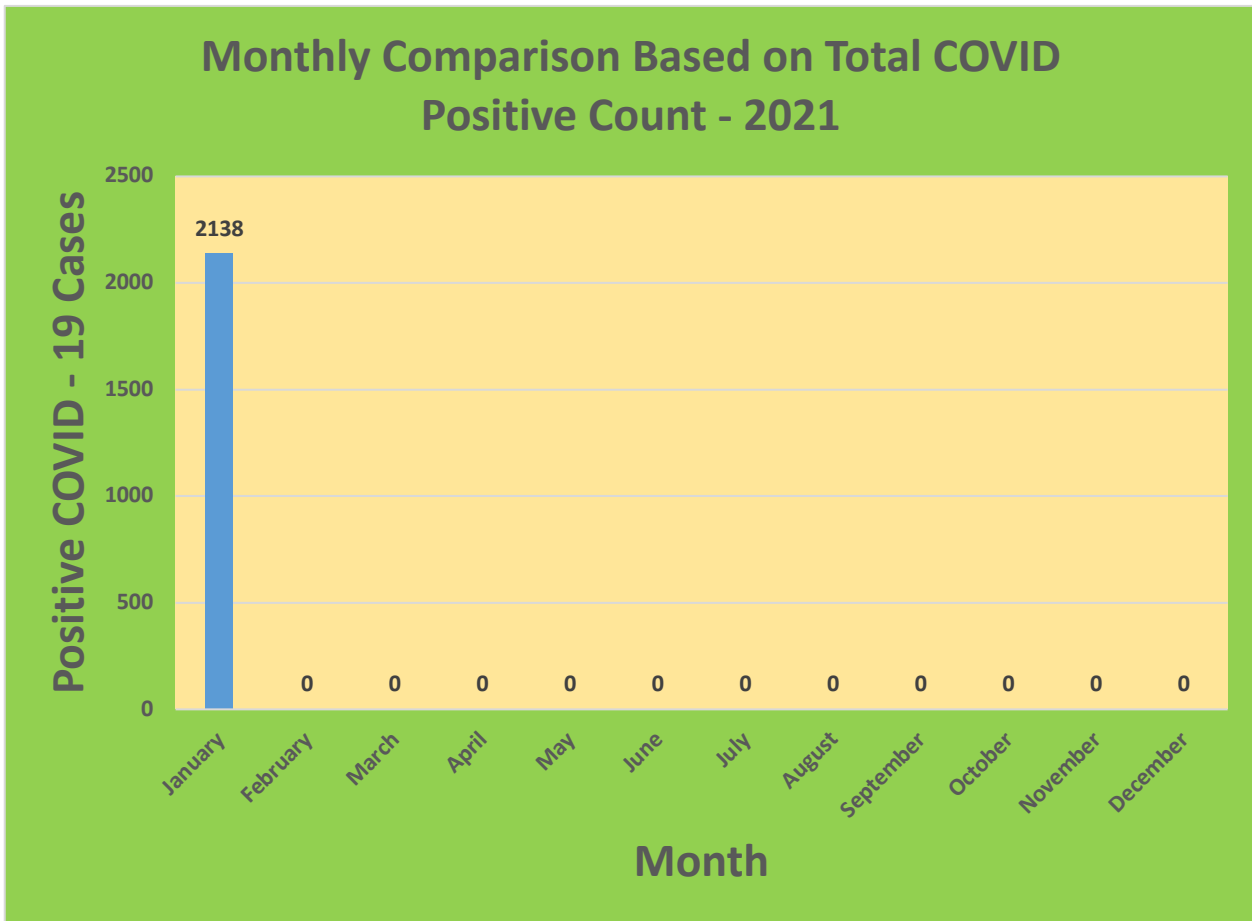
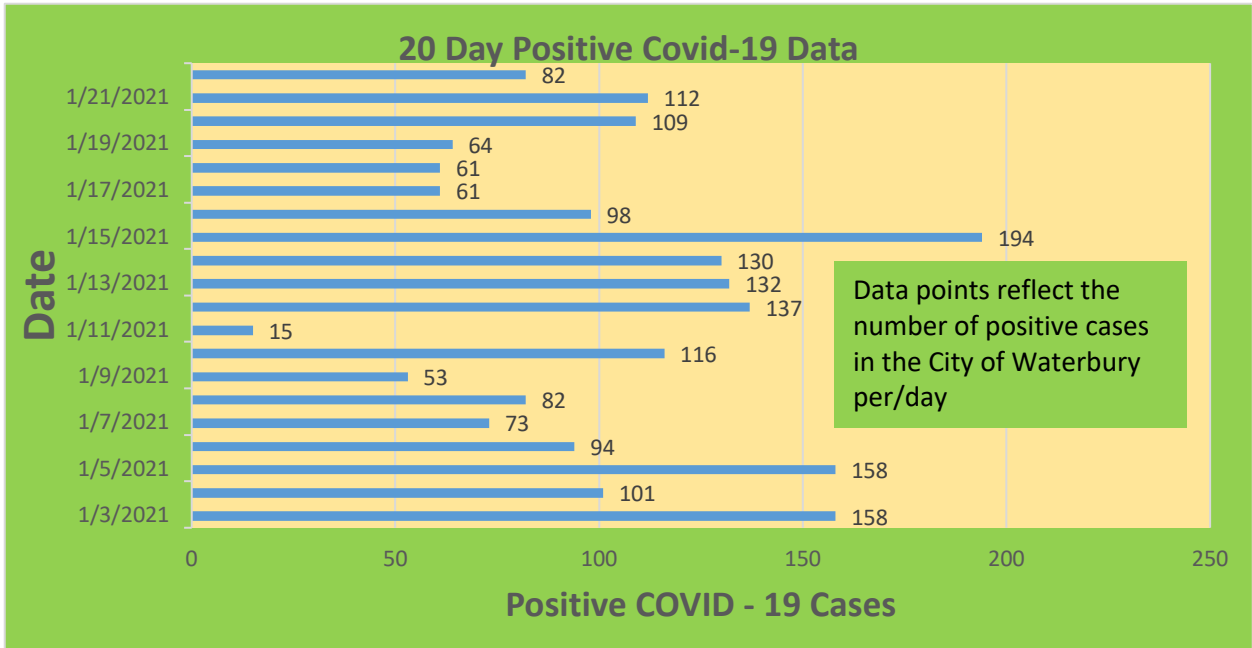

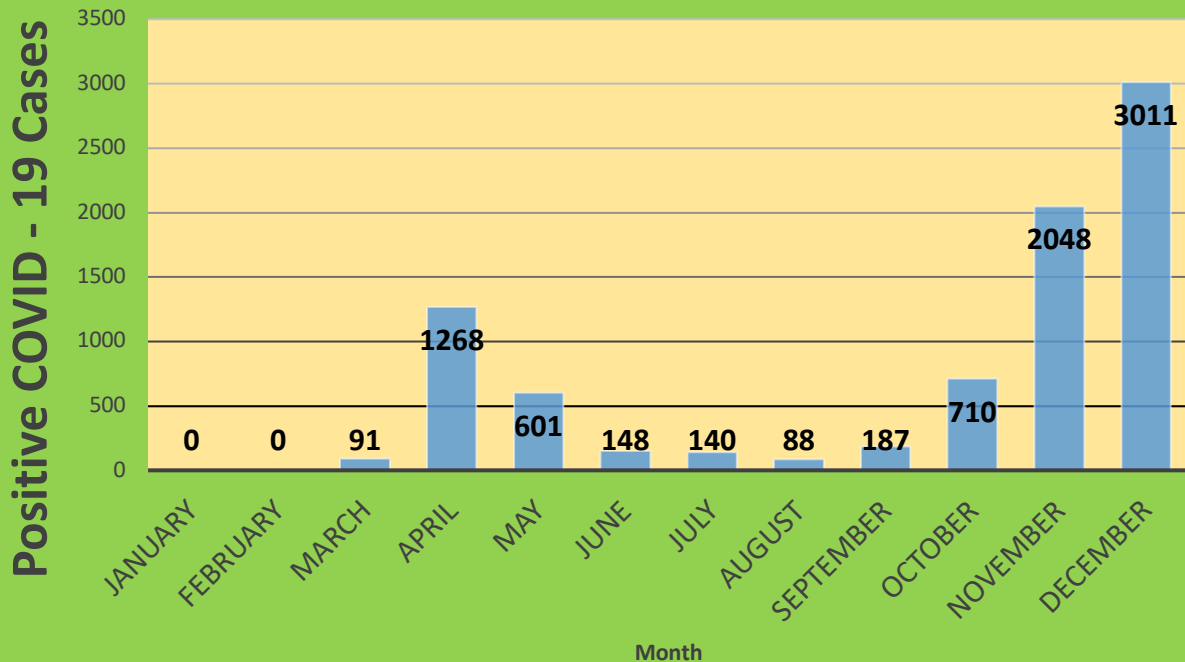
