**City of Waterbury Daily Coronavirus Update**  
**April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

As of April 28<sup>th</sup> 2021, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 15,912. Twenty-seven patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 369 COVID-19-associated deaths.

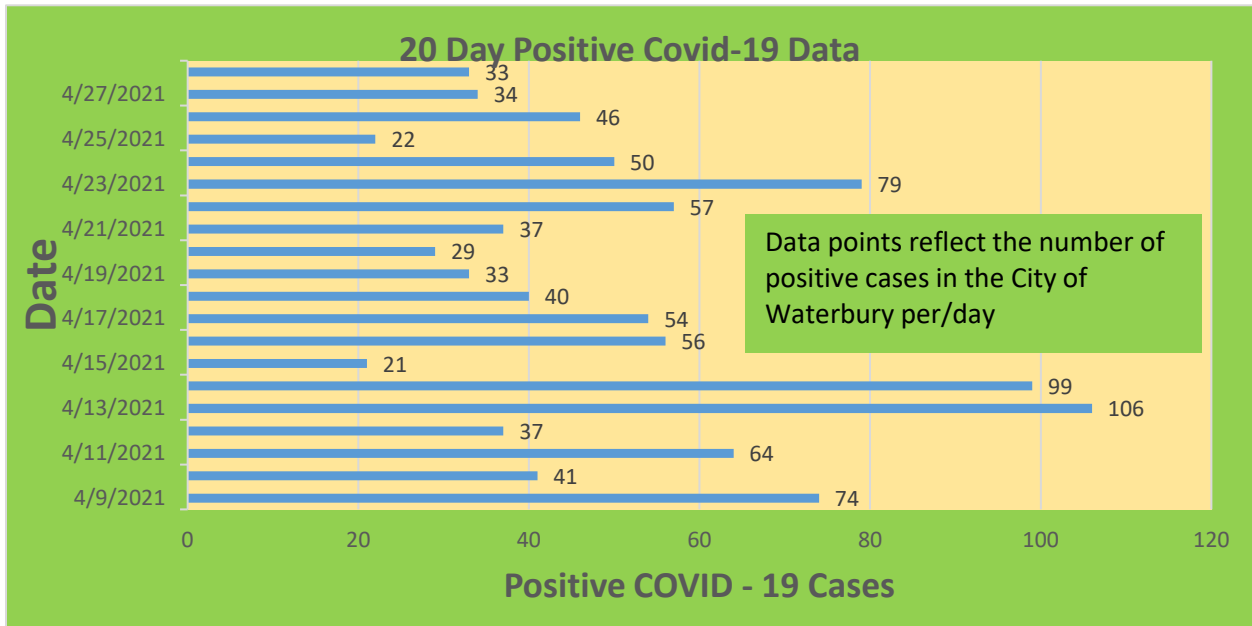
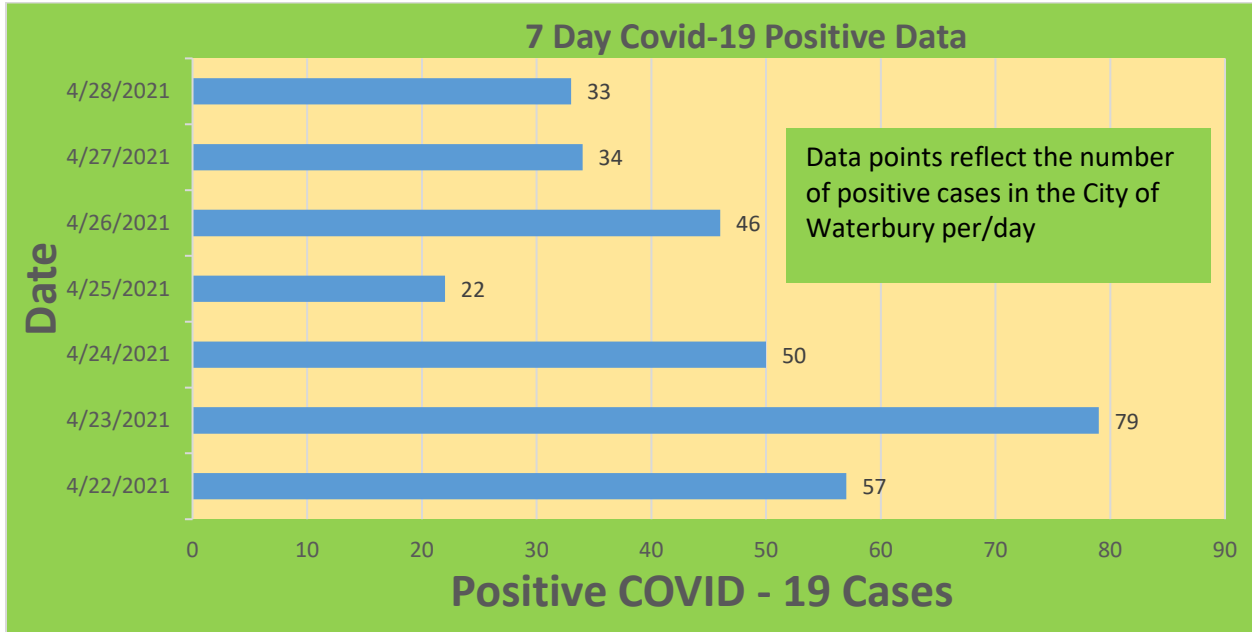

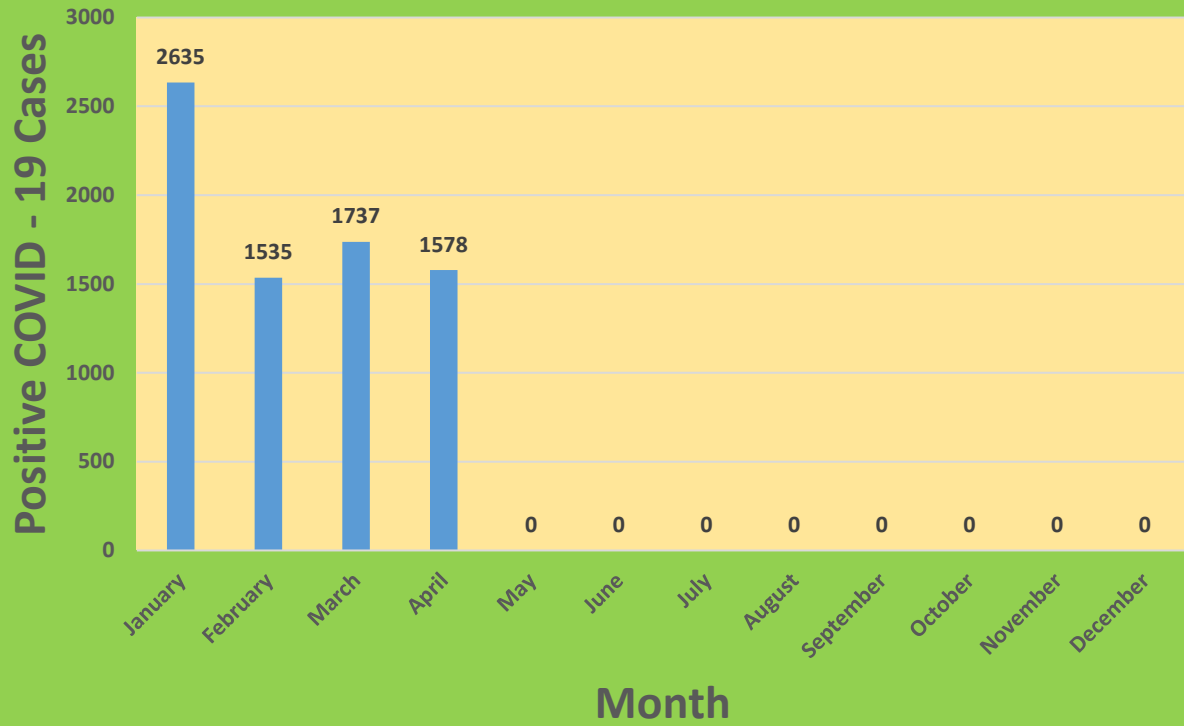

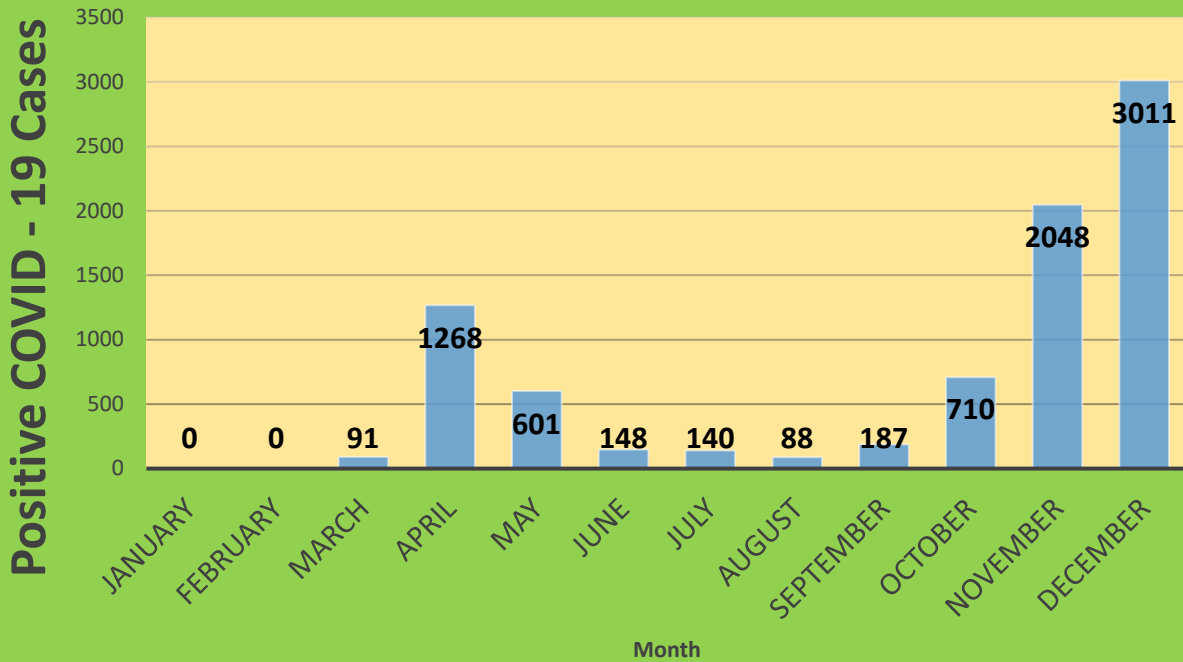

**COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics Located in Waterbury:**

As of Thursday April 1<sup>st</sup>, Connecticut residents aged 16 and over are eligible to schedule COVID-19 vaccination appointments as the State advances its vaccination program by age bracket.

- Appointments can be made online by means of VAMS, the CDC’s Vaccine Administration Management System; an email address is needed for each person seeking vaccination. The VAMS portal is at: <https://vams.cdc.gov/vaccineportal/s/login>
- Trained United Way of Connecticut contact specialists are available to take phone calls to schedule vaccine appointments from 8 am to 8 pm, seven days per week. Contact specialists will have the capability of booking up to 10,000 appointments at twelve locations across the state. Appointments can be made on the telephone by calling the state’s Vaccine Appointment Assist Line at 1-877-918-2224.
- You can also schedule an appointment directly with the Waterbury Department of Public Health by calling 3-1-1.
- Vaccination is by appointment only; appointments can be scheduled at sites below located in the City of Waterbury.
