**City of Waterbury Daily Coronavirus Update**  
**April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

As of April 29<sup>th</sup> 2021, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 15,983. Twenty-seven patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 392 COVID-19-associated deaths.

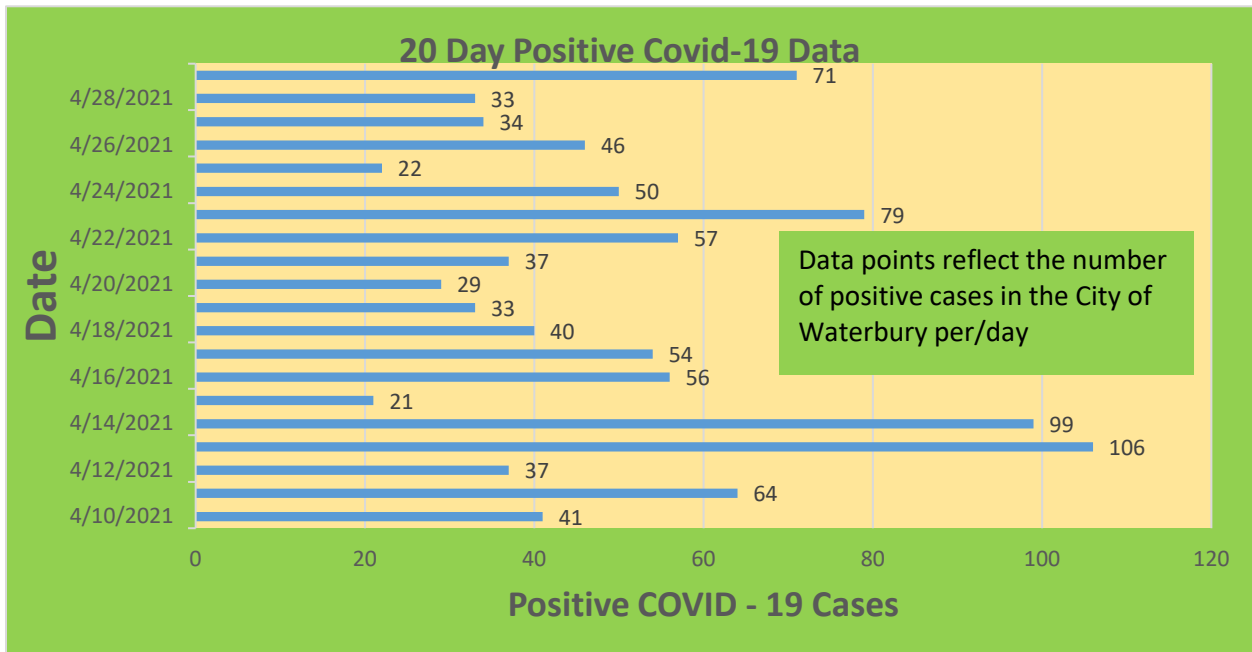
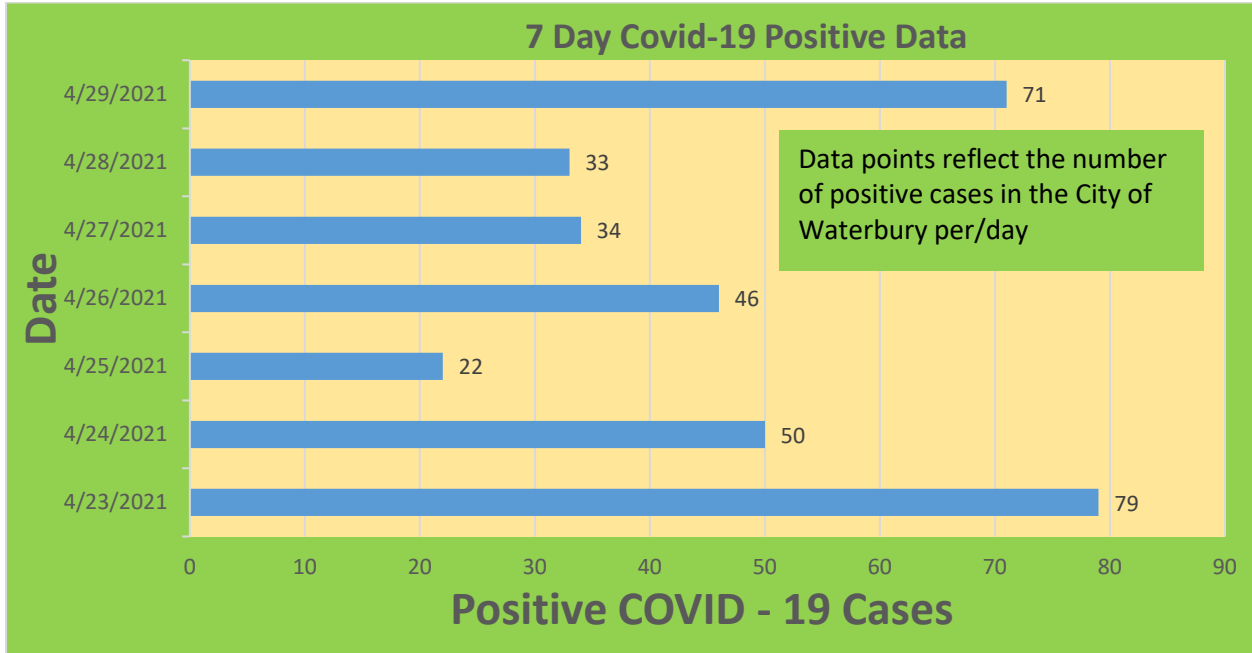

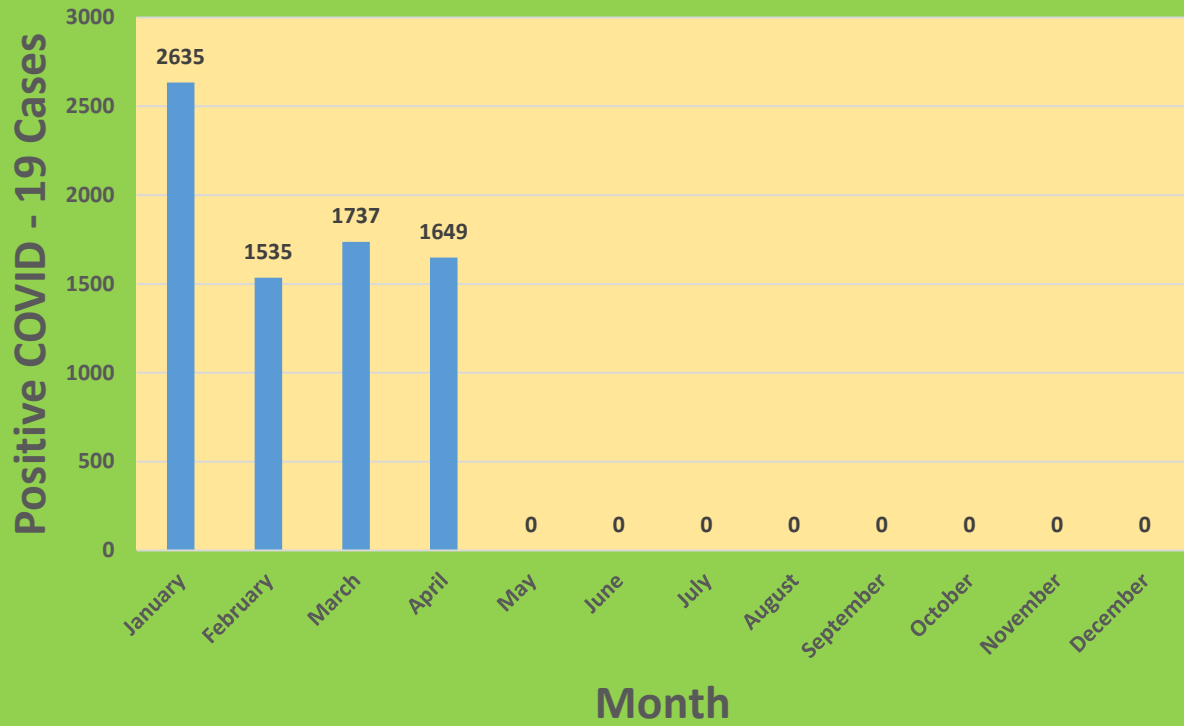

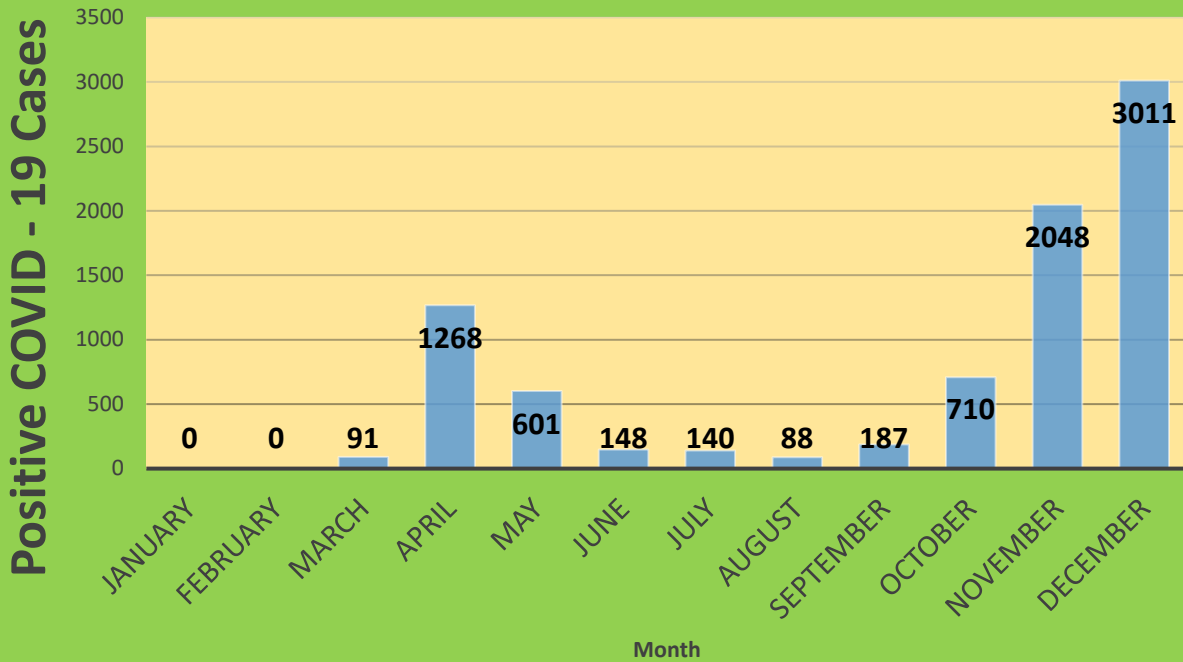
