City of Waterbury Daily Coronavirus Update
April 30th, 2021

As of April 30th 2021, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 16,013. Twenty-seven patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 393 COVID-19-associated deaths.

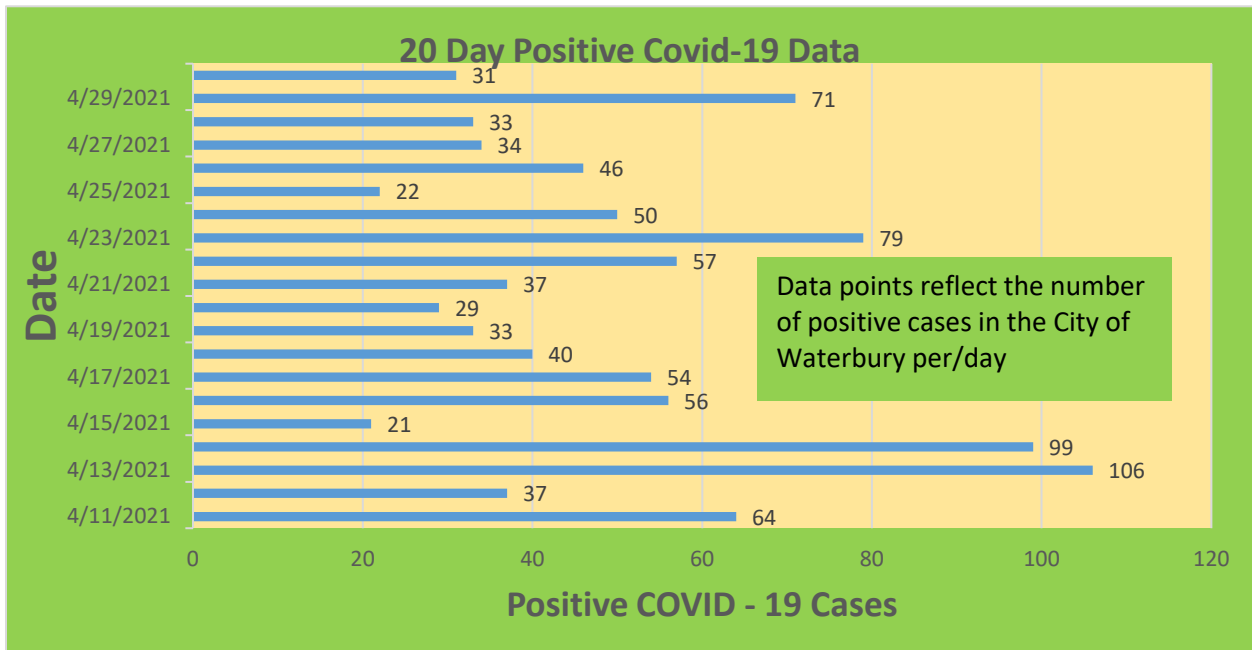
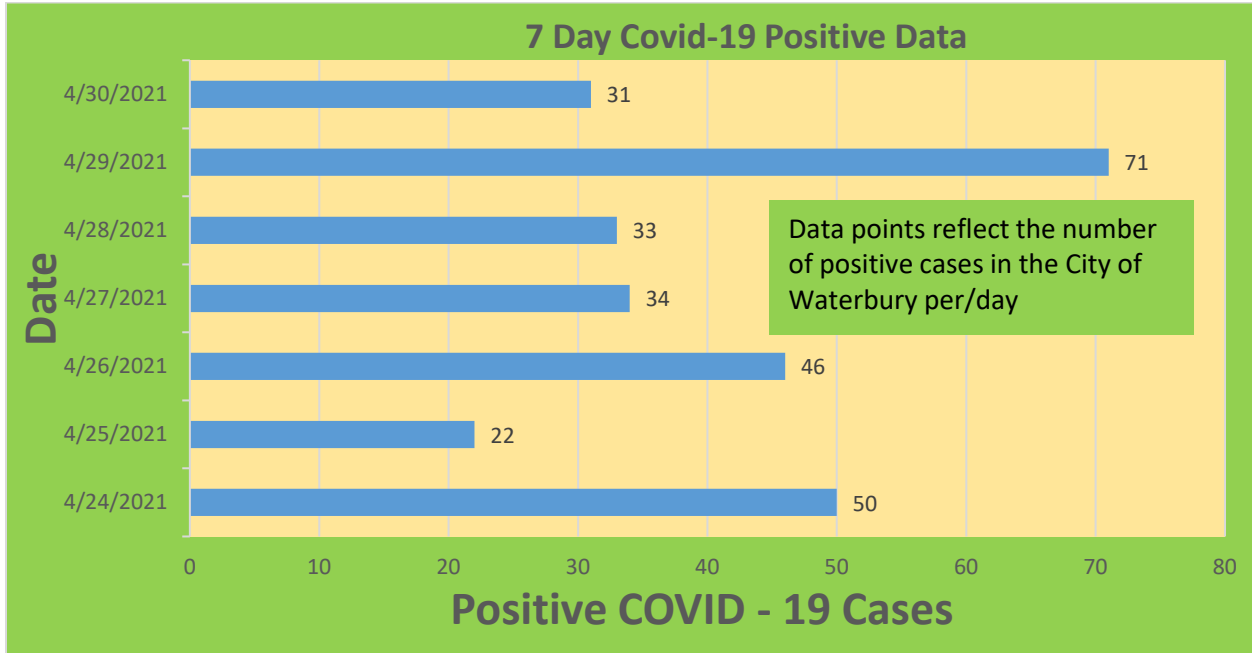

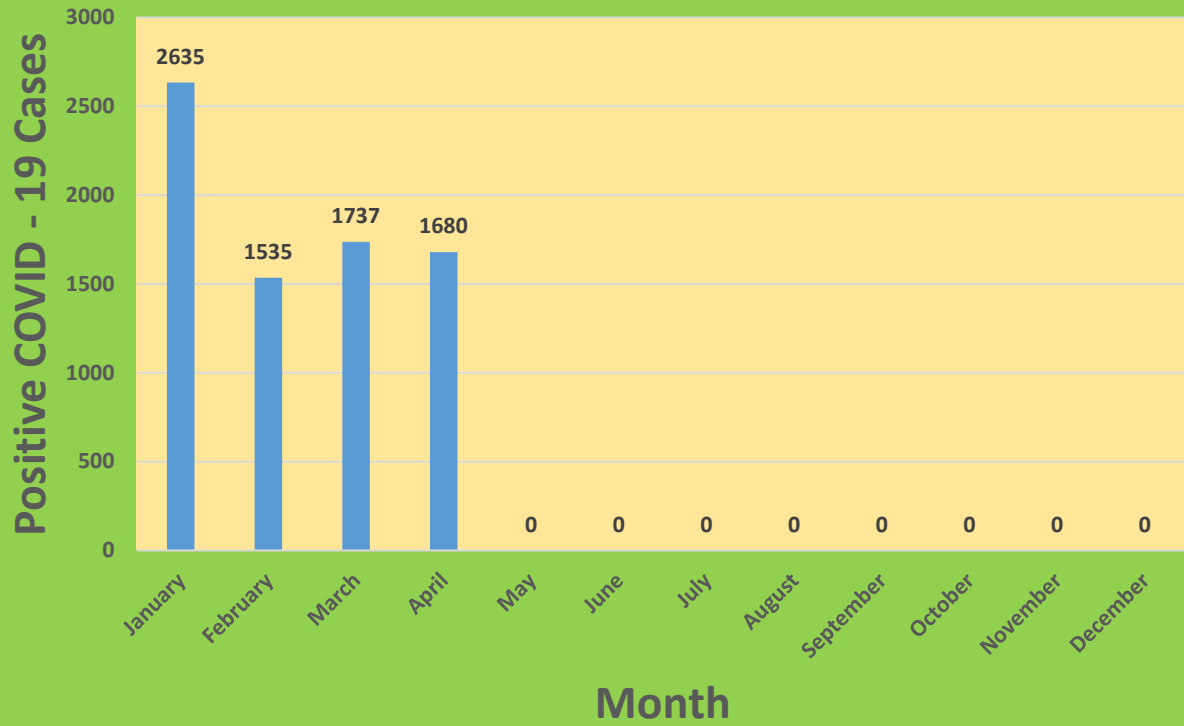

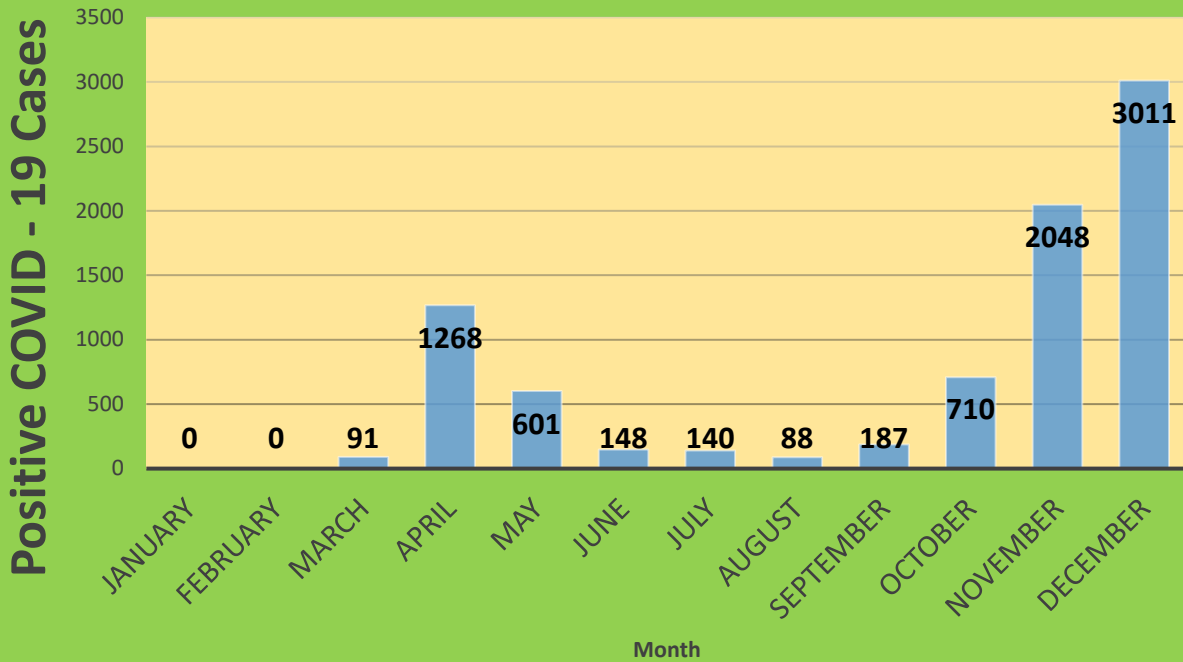
