

# Mayor Neil M. O'Leary City of Waterbury Daily Coronavirus Update May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

As of May 1<sup>st</sup> 2021, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 16,047. Twenty-seven patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 393 COVID-19-associated deaths.






