**City of Waterbury Daily Coronavirus Update**  
**May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

As of May 4<sup>th</sup> 2021, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 16,157. Twenty-four patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 393 COVID-19-associated deaths.

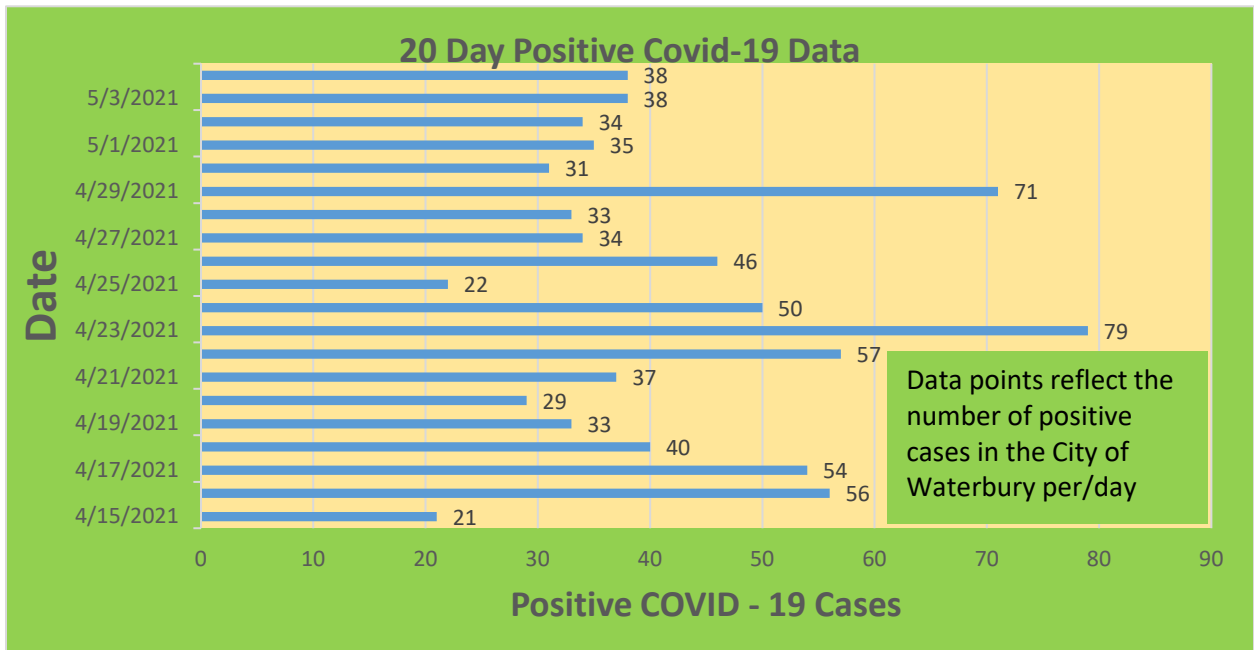

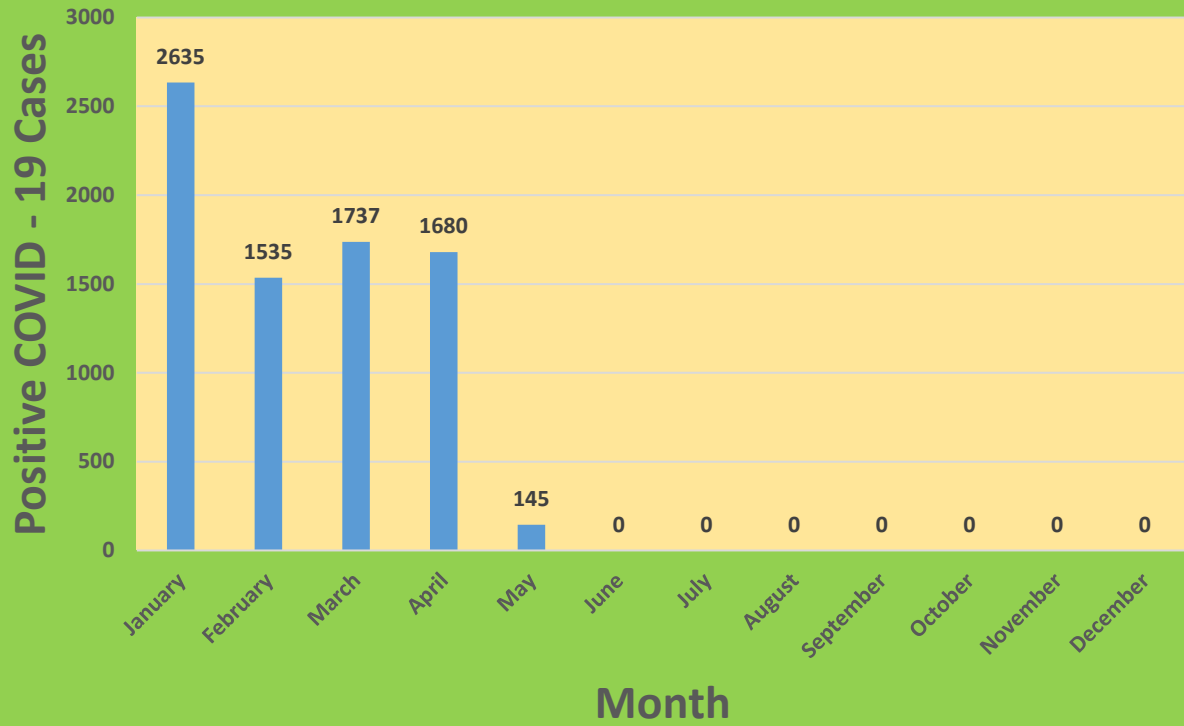

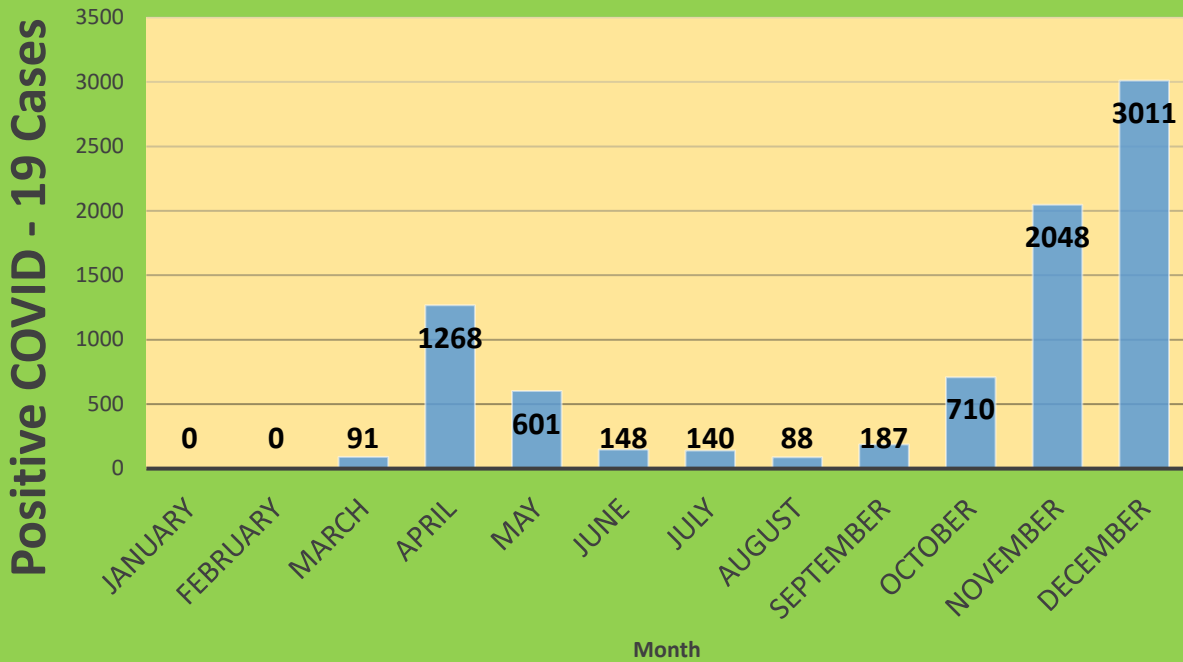
