**October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

As of October 17th, 2020, at 4:00 PM, the total of laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases reported among Waterbury residents is 2,812. Eleven patients are currently hospitalized with laboratory-confirmed COVID-19. There have been 193 COVID-19-associated deaths.

### **Waterbury Public School COVID Updates**

**(As of 10/16/20):**

- **Duggan Elementary School:**
  - Two staff members tested positive. (no additional class/school closure)
- **Adult Education Program:**
  - 1 staff member tested positive. (ALL students and staff transitioned to distance learning through Tuesday, October 20<sup>th</sup>)

**(As of 10/14/20):**

- **Carrington Elementary School:**
  - One student has tested positive. (*specific class will transition to distance learning through 10/22*)
- **Driggs Elementary School:**
  - One student has tested positive. (*specific class will transition to distance learning through 10/23*)
- **There are NO school closures.**

**(As of 10/13/20):**

- **Kennedy High School:**
  - One virtual student has tested positive. (*student has been learning from home for several weeks*)
  - One student has tested positive. (*no class or school closure required*)

**(As of 10/12/20):**

- **Waterbury Career Academy:**
  - One virtual student has tested positive. (*Student has been learning from home since the first day of school*)
- **Tinker Elementary School:**
  - One student has tested positive. (*no class or school closure required*)
- **West Side Middle School:**
  - One student has tested positive. (*impacted class will transition to distance learning through 10/22*)
- **Waterbury Arts Magnet School:**
  - One student has tested positive. (*impacted classes will transition to distance learning through 10/22*)
